

HOW TO INSTALL FONTS IN VISTA

Windows Vista comes with a huge array of fonts but if you need to have *Fonts4Teachers* on your computer you have to install them.

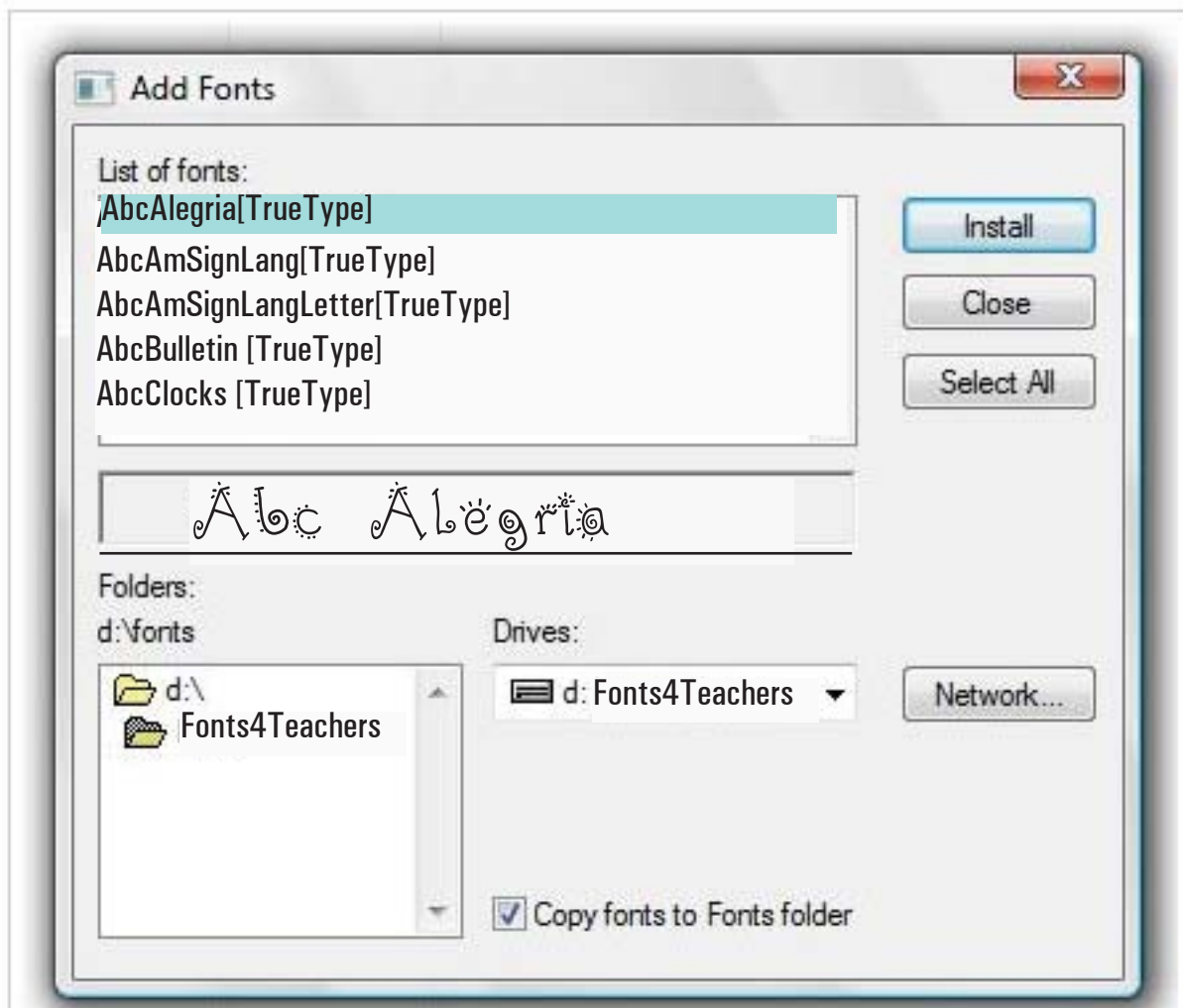
So, how to Install New Fonts in Windows Vista?

Step 1:

Go to **Control Panel -> Appearance and Personalization -> Fonts**



Step 2: You will be taken to the System's fonts folder. Right click anywhere inside the folder and click **add fonts**. You will be given a pop-up box which will aid in installing new fonts.



Step 3:

Using the Drop down menu at '**Drives**', select the folder where you have kept the **Fonts4Teachers** fonts' files (if you are installing from the **Fonts4Teachers** CD-ROM go to Drives 'd', 'e', etc. If you are installing from the web or e-mail (meaning that you downloaded the fonts), then choose drive 'c' and look for the fonts on the directory where they have been saved).

Step 4:

You will see the **Fonts4Teachers** fonts listed under '**List of Fonts**'.

Step 5:

You can preview each font style below by highlighting them. To install, go to 'Select All' and click '**Install**'.

Step 6:

Make sure you have selected '**Copy fonts to fonts folder**', so that you can manage all the font files easily.

Step 7:

Close all the windows (and remove the **Fonts4Teachers** CD if you installed the fonts from here.)
